SENATE BILL 08-122

BY SENATOR(S) Windels, Boyd, Groff, Tochtrop; and Williams; also REPRESENTATIVE(S) Carroll M., Carroll M., Casso, Labuda, Soper, and Todd.

CONCERNING THE PROHIBITION OF ACTION AGAINST AN EMPLOYEE FOR SHARING WAGE INFORMATION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 24-34-402 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH to read:

24-34-402. Discriminatory or unfair employment practices.

(1) It shall be a discriminatory or unfair employment practice:

(i) UNLESS OTHERWISE PERMITTED BY FEDERAL LAW, FOR AN EMPLOYER TO DISCHARGE, DISCIPLINE, DISCRIMINATE AGAINST, COERCE, INTIMIDATE, THREATEN, OR INTERFERE WITH ANY EMPLOYEE OR OTHER PERSON BECAUSE THE EMPLOYEE INQUIRED ABOUT T, DISCLOSED, COMPARED, OR OTHERWISE DISCUSSED THE EMPLOYEE'S WAGES; TO REQUIRE AS A CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT NONDISCLOSURE BY AN EMPLOYEE OF HIS OR HER WAGES OR TO REQUIRE AN EMPLOYEE TO SIGN A WAIVER OR OTHER DOCUMENT THAT PURPORTS TO DENY AN EMPLOYEE THE RIGHT TO DISCLOSE HIS OR HER WAGE INFORMATION WHO ARE EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE "NATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS ACT", 29 U.S.C. SEC 151 ET SEQ.

Capital letters indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through words indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.

SECTION 2. Effective date applicability. (1) This act shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly that is allowed for submitting a referendum petition pursuant to article V. section 1 (3) of the state constitution, (August 6, 2008, if adjournment sine die is on May 7, 2008); except that, if a referendum petition is filed against this act or an item, section, or part, of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part, if approved by the people, shall take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by proclamation of the governor.

THE COLORADO IRS/PRACTITIONER LIAISON COMMITTEE MEETING OF JULY 7, 2008

The Colorado IRS/Practitioner Liaison Committee was started with a meeting July, 7th, 2008 at the IRS offices in downtown Denver. The idea for an IRS/Practitioner Liaison committee has been developed in Texas and has proven to be successful, so far, in helping the IRS and Practitioners to interact with one another and discuss concerns and methods and to keep the lines of communication open between both sides of a tax return. The IRS was well represented with members of the Service from all areas, including, but not limited to; agents, legal, appeals, investigations, tax payer advocate's office, and of course, the Stakeholder's Liaison. The Practitioner side was represented by Enrolled Agents, CPA's and Tax Attorneys.

Areas of concern that were discussed between the parties was started with concerns of getting tax information into the hands of new business owners. In particular, someone who wants to start a business but it unsure of what type of entity, what's involved and expected of each entity, etc. It was discussed that either the IRS could 1.) have a pop up window once the SS-4 was completed that would outline to the new business how to proceed and what steps to take for successful record keeping. 2.) have a colorful brochure that could be included in with the paper copy of the EIN when sent out that would outline steps for successful record keeping. On the Practitioner side, it was pointed out that several times by the time the Practitioner receives the account the business owner has not maintained or realized the importance of keeping accurate records, making it harder to prepare an accurate return

Another area of concern that was discussed was the abuse of do-it-yourself tax preparation programs. It was pointed out that anyone could buy a copy of a tax preparation program, hang out a shingle and start preparing returns for anyone, without having to sign on as paid preparer. This situation is leaving several taxpayers with incorrectly prepared tax returns and no method of recourse. The IRS has no suggestions at this time as to how this practice could be more regulated to prevent the abuse of home tax programs.

The IRS was complimented on the hiring of more experienced agents who are more familiar with the Practitioner side of a tax return out in the field, making audits easier and quicker. The IRS complimented the Practitioner side by saying that most of the time, when their auditors show up, the Practitioner's are prepared for them and have documentation when needed.

E-Services passwords are required to be changed and the IRS encourages all practitioners registered with E-Services to log on and verify that the IRS has the correct e-mail address as password renewal notifications will be e-mailed out to the e-mail address registered with the IRS.

Client confidentiality was discussed as an issue. Should a Practitioner have a 2848 on file for a client and want a staff member in the office in on the discussion with the IRS the client must give verbal permission for the IRS agent to speak in front of the staff member not represented on a 2848.

It was mentioned that at this time, Conservation Easements are a big issue and several are being investigated as being tax evasion. If your client is looking to do a conservation easement in the near future please encourage them to research carefully to make sure it is one that would be approved by the IRS and State taxing authorities.

Investigations of ERO's at this time is more based on the rate of reject returns. With a 25% reject rate guaranteeing a visit from an investigator. Most of the investigations are centering around who is preparing the returns. On other investigations, the security of the offices is being investigated.

National Tax Phone Forums are offered online monthly for CPE credit and are free. Information for signing up and participating is found on the IRS website. All practitioners are encouraged to participate.

The electronic filing of 1040 tax returns is being updated with the IRS expecting to have a more modernized system up around August, 2009.
